



GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS

Volume: 1,5-2 pages, MSWord (.doc, .docx);

Language: English;

Paper size: A4;

Margins: left – 30 mm, right – 15 mm, top and bottom – 20 mm;

Font: Times New Roman; font size - 12 pt,

Paragraphs: alignment justified, paragraph indention – 12,5 mm, spacing 6 pts, single lining;

Title: in bold type, capital letters, Times New Roman, font size - 12 pt, center alignment;

Name of authors: in bold type, capital letters, font size - 12 pt, Times New Roman, right alignment;

Affiliations: font size - 12 pt, Times New Roman, right alignment, single lining;

Affiliations include data of the authors at the beginning of the abstract as follows:

- Name, Surname, Degree;
- Organization;
- Telephone, Email.

Structure of abstracts:

1. Introduction (1 paragraph)
 - arguments explaining the topicality of the research and its novelty;
 - a brief review of the literature on the problem.
2. Main part (1-3 paragraphs)
 - description of the solutions to the problem.
3. Conclusion (1 paragraph)
 - the main findings of the study;
 - further recommendations, if possible.
4. References (3-4 sources)
 - text references using square brackets.
